What is the Liquorpond Patient Participation Group (PPG)?

Basically, our PPG comprises of a group of patients, registered here, who meet with practice staff on a regular basis to discuss topics of mutual interest and to make positive suggestions as to how our service to patients can be continually improved.

When and where do we meet?

Our PPG meets at the Practice, four times a year at 7.30pm on a Thursday evening.

Who chairs the meeting?

The PPG has an elected Chairperson and an elected Vice Chairperson, both of whom normally hold office for a one year term, with the possibility of re-election after that time.

What if I am unable to attend meetings?

We understand that attending meetings regularly is not always possible, so don't worry if you have to miss the occasional one.

If, however, you do not want to attend any meetings at all and prefer to just be involved 'remotely', then that is also fine. You can still have your say as part of a wider 'virtual' group and be contacted only via email.
